- Children 3 or 4 years of age by September 1, 2010
- Reside in Harrison County
- Homeless
- Foster, TANF, SSI Recipient
- Children with diagnosed disabilities



ITEMS NEEDED TO APPLY:

- Certified Birth Certificate
- 121 Certificate of Compliance (RECORD OF SHOTS)
- Social Security Number (ALL FAMILY MEMBERS)
- Proof of Residency
- Documentation from DHS on Foster Children

PROOF OF INCOME:

- W2 Form -2009/ 1040 Tax Return- 2009/ Transcript IRS Printout
- 1099 Form
- Benefit letter from SSI
- Benefit Statement: Social Security Retirement/Social Security Survival
- Letter from Employer
- Award Letter from TANF
- Unemployment/Verification from WIN job center
