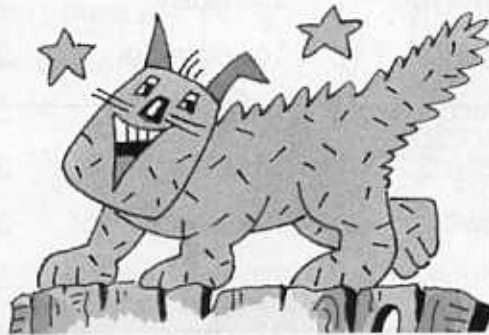

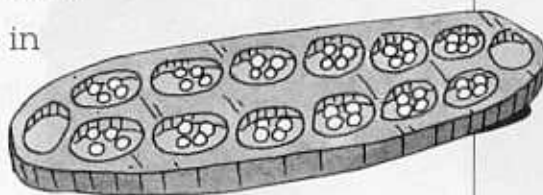
Multicultural Connection

GAMES People of all cultures enjoy games. Read about the board games below, and then write the answers.

Mankala A game played in Africa and the Middle East

A board has two rows of six cups. Players transfer beans or pebbles from one cup to another. The object of the game is to win the most beans. Mankala means "transferring."

Stone Toss An American Indian game

Players use a flat basket as a board and stones that are decorated on one side. A player shakes the basket to toss the stones. If the stone lands with the decorated side up, the player wins points.
