

How Can My Child Receive a BLUE RIBBON?

To receive a **BLUE RIBBON** a student must satisfy a topic's passing requirements the very first time he/she works on the topic.

The passing requirements are based on a minimum number of questions answered and a minimum percentage correct.

Because there is no minimum passing requirements for the *Pretests*, all students receive a Blue Ribbon.

This student scored a **BLUE RIBBON** in Phonics. Here is why...

The child:

- answered 12 questions
- scored an 83.3%

The “*Passing Goal Items/Score*” needed were:

- answer a minimum of 10 questions
- score a 70% or higher
