The first column, **Your Results, Items: Score**, indicates your child's actual results. The number in front of the colon refers to the number of questions your child answered. The second number refers to the percentage of correct answers.

The second column, **Passing Goal, Items: Score**, indicates the minimum passing requirements. The number in front of the colon refers to the number of questions your child must answer. The second number refers to the minimum percentage they need to pass this topic.

The **Pretest** does not have a minimum passing score because there are topics they might not have learned in their grade level yet, and they are not expected to have mastered these topics.

*\* Remember...* Anything that is highlighted in blue is **clickable**. Click on your child's scores to find more detailed information about their performance, such as the specific kinds of items your child missed.

## What do the SYMBOLS mean?



The **BLUE RIBBON** means that your child satisfied the topic's minimum passing requirements.



The **YIELD** sign and the **RED ARROW** means that the student did not pass the topic's minimum requirements and has been assigned a building block lesson to help improve the skills needed to pass the topic. Once the topic is passed, the student can go back and pass the original topic.



The **BUILDING BLOCK** means that the student is working on improving the skills needed to pass the minimum requirements of a topic.

**FB Far Below:** student has performed below the passing proficiency requirement for that topic. For example, in the above report, the student received an **FB** in Decoding Words. The passing proficiency was to achieve 68%.. this student only scored 46.2%.

**PP Partially Proficient:** student has **partially** passed the proficiency requirement for that topic.

**P Proficient:** student has passed the proficiency requirement for that topic.

**A Advanced Proficiency:** student has far surpassed the proficiency requirement for that topic.
