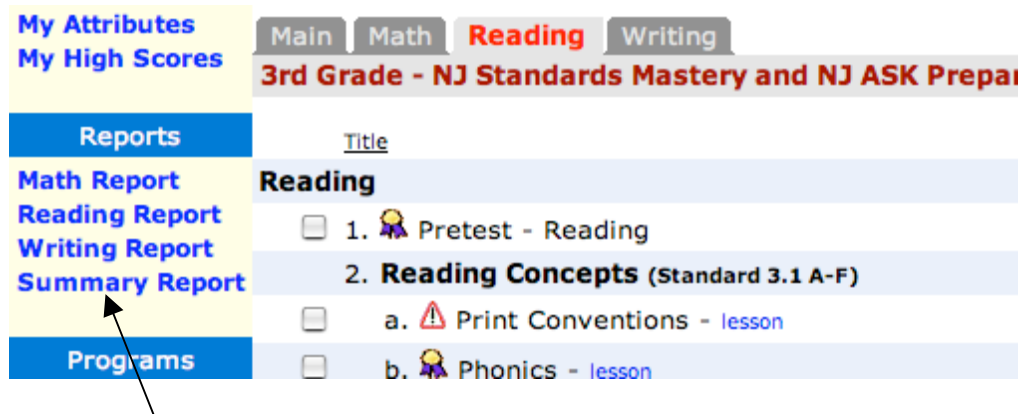


# What Will I Learn About my Child's Progress by Running a Report?



1. Select a **Subject Area** that you would like to run a report, i.e., Math, Reading, Writing, etc. This menu can be found on the left side menu *after* your child logs in.

2. After you select the desired report, a Pop-Up Window appears that will provide many details about your child's performance, such as how many sessions your child worked on a particular topic, the amount of time spent per topic, the percentage correct, the types of items they missed, as well as their performance **\*grades**. You can even compare their results to other BC students in their grade level, as well as other grade level peers in the state participating in Study Island.
