





How many can you find?</p>	<p>15</p> <p>Notice how many times meteorologists use numbers during the news. What do those numbers tell us?</p>	<p>16</p> <p>Sometimes weather may postpone an activity. This can be upsetting. Talk about some strategies to deal with the delay.</p>	<p>17</p> <p>Return the books to the library and check out more!</p> 
<p>18</p> <p>Imagine what it is like to paint with clouds! Use cotton balls to paint!</p>	<p>19</p> <p>Check the weather each morning this week to find out what the temperature daily. Write it next to the weather on this calendar.</p>	<p>20</p> <p>You might use a computer, or television to check the temperature. What is the instrument's name to measure temperature?</p>	<p>21</p> <p>Take advantage of daylight savings, take a walk after dinner. Find a few sticks and make the letter W.</p>	<p>22</p> <p>What was the coldest day this week? What was the warmest? How do you know?</p>	<p>23</p> <p>Sometimes weather can be severe. What is your family's weather safety plan? How does your child know to be safe?</p>	<p>24</p> <p>Create an obstacle course inside or outside that challenges various motor skills - jumping, running, kicking, rolling, etc.</p>
