



Parents and Guardians are encouraged to read the Student Handbook for complete information about Biloxi Public School District and Biloxi Jr. High School.

The following is a list of general facts for quick reference:

- Students are not allowed on campus prior to 7:30 am. The school will not assume responsibility for any student arriving on school grounds prior to stated time unless they are transported by school bus.
- School begins at 7:55 am and ends at 3:15 pm.
- A student must ride the bus that is assigned to him/her to and from school. Bus change is based on residency which must be provided to the school. Temporary request must be approved through the Transportation Department at #228-436-5140.
- Car riders are dropped off and picked up at the west side of campus, by the Gym.
- Book bags are permitted on campus. They do NOT have to be clear or mesh.
- All holidays and important dates such as progress reports, report cards, etc. are found in the Handbook as well as the website: www.biloxischools.net.
- There are NO lockers for students at BJHS.
- When necessary, textbooks will be assigned to students to bring home. If textbooks are assigned it is then that the parent/guardian is responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged textbooks.
- A classroom copy of textbooks will be available; there is no need to transport the textbook given to the student.
- Student grades can be accessed online by going to www.biloxischools.net and clicking on the link that says “Grades.” Parents/guardians will need to contact their child’s counselor to obtain a login ID and password.
- Teachers at BJHS are available for after school tutoring and will distribute their tutoring schedule to students. Students must sign-up for tutoring by completing the appropriate form with the teacher. Tutoring forms should be submitted to the teacher with whom they are staying at least a day before he/she plans to attend. Late buses will be provided for after school tutoring on Tuesdays and Thursdays, or students may be picked up in back of the school by the gym at **4:00**.

- Breakfast is \$ 1.25, and lunch is \$ 2.60. Lunch applications are available for the free and reduced lunch program. All students must pay full price until the application has
